July 31 to August 7: Deserts, Mountains, Canyons and Birds: From Phoenix

Southeastern Arizona may be the most exciting birding venue in the United States (as well as my favorite). Many of the birds are “Mexican species”, which range just north of the border. The mountain ranges where we bird are often referred to as “Mexican Mountains”. They are the northern most extremity of the Sierra Madre Mts. of Mexico. Biologically they are more closely related to the Sierra Madre than the Rocky Mts. to the north. The avifauna of this region is truly unique. In the past participants have had over 90 life birds on this trip. At this time of year the monsoon season is under way, cooling the temperature as well as greening up the desert and grassland habitat. Of special interest this time of year is the variety of hummingbirds with 12 species possible.
